Phonics Activity



After joining in with today's phonics video, we would like you to try writing the following words in a phoneme frame. Remember that each 'sound' that you hear needs to go in a different space. For example, the digraph 'sh' would go into 1 square, like below.

f	i	sh

fish, chip, chill, wish, sock, pen, thing, shop, shot

Today, we would like you to find the rhyming words that you can hear in the story. Listen out for them when you are watching the story or listening to it. Here are some examples;

far and *star*, *fly* and *sky*, *said* and *head*, *flew* and *blue*,

Have a go at writing the words or use the magnetic letters to make them instead. You could also try writing some sentences using the rhyming words.



Maths Activity

For our maths activity today, we would like you to play a game of splat!



Write some numbers onto some paper. Say a number and get your child to 'splat' the correct one. They could use their hand or a spatula if you have one! Give them clues, such as 'Splat the number that comes after 2.' 'Splat the number that is 1 more than 4.' etc..
