Nursery Learning Activities w/b 11th January 2021 The Very Hungry Caterpillar

This week we will be continuing to look at 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' by Eric Carle.

The children in Nursery have been interested to learn more about caterpillars so we will be looking at a caterpillar's lifecycle.

Art – Can the children design their own beautiful butterfly?

They might want to make a symmetrical butterfly if they have paint at home. They could paint one side and fold it over!

Maths

In Maths we are going to be weighing fruit and other foods. We have different kinds of scales but you could also use your hands to judge! We are using words like heavy, heavier, heaviest, light, lighter and lightest.

We are also going to continue with counting and writing numbers – taking on the challenge of 10!

What numbers can the children find around the house or on a daily walk?
