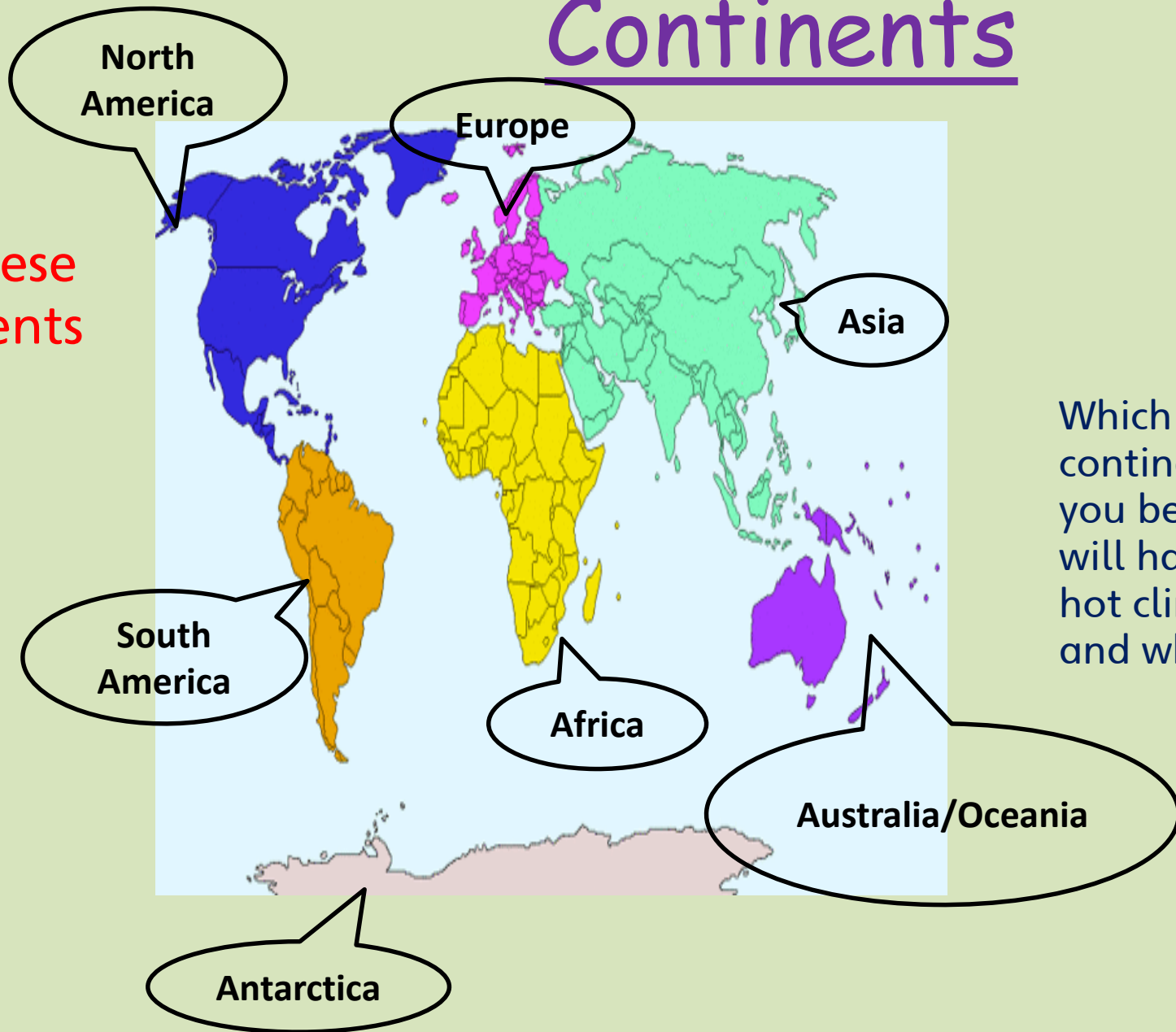

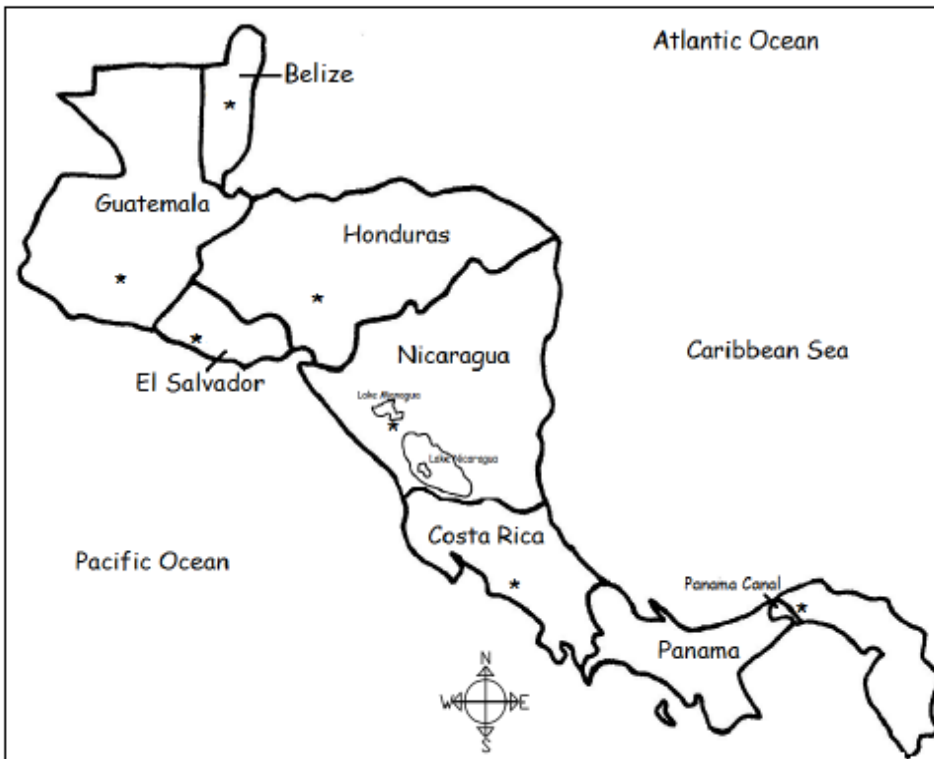

Central America consists of seven countries that connect North America to South America, with Mexico to the north and Colombia to the southeast. The seven countries of Central America are: Belize, Guatemala, Honduras, El Salvador, Nicaragua, Costa Rica, and Panama. The main language of Central America is Spanish, although English is the official language of Belize.
