Maths Activity

This week, we are really focusing on the fact that a number can be made up of smaller numbers. But still only numbers up to 5. Once you have joined in with the activities on the video, try the following activities together:

Show your child an empty feely bag (this is any kind of bag that isn't see through) or you could use an empty box instead. Count out 4 pebbles, beans, coins etc. into the bag. Make sure that your child does this with you so that they can see how many items are in the bag / box. Take some out (don't show your child!) and put them in your hand. Talk with your child about how many **could** be in your hand and how many **could** be left in the bag. Show your child how many you have and then repeat this with different amounts.
