To June,

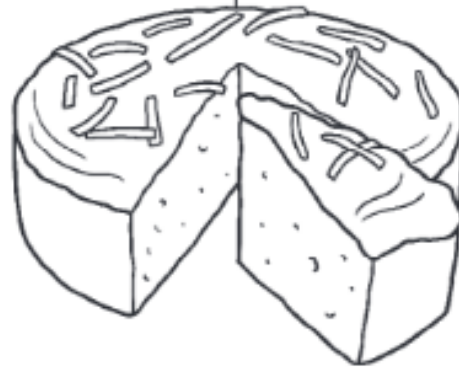
I am on a visit to see my gran and her new dog. His name is Duke. He is so cute.
