


Britain at War

Key question 1

 If the First World War was so horrific, why did Britain go to war again just 20 years later?

We know the sequence of events.

Today we are going to look more closely at the actions of Britain, under the then Prime Minister, Neville Chamberlain.



Appeasement

Appease means letting someone have their way. It was the way the British government dealt with Hitler's Germany before the Second World War.

It is mostly associated with the British Prime Minister Neville Chamberlain.


Hitler was allowed to take over areas of land in Europe, without a fight, in the hope that he would stop making any further demands.

Britain allowed Hitler to have his way.

Was appeasement the right choice?

Appeasement: Britain allowed Hitler to have his way.

For appeasement	Against appeasement	
Britain was not ready for the war and needed time to build new aeroplanes and strengthen it's army.	Perhaps, appeasement encouraged Hitler to make more demands.	
The British public was strongly against another war. They had terrible memories of World War I.	Appeasement gave Germany time to build their weapons and armed forces.	
Chamberlain still trusted Hitler to keep his word and thought he could negotiate a peaceful solution	Appeasement didn't actually stop the war. It just delayed it and may have encouraged Hitler to be more aggressive.	
Britain was still recovering from the Great Depression which followed the Wall Street Crash in 1929 and could not afford a war	It was obvious Hitler wasn't going to be stopped. Hitler had shown his true intentions when he reoccupied the Rhineland, marched into Austria and threatened to go to war to separate Sudetenland from Czechoslovakia.	
Chamberlain thought that the Germans had been too harshly treated after the First World War and deserved to get land back.
