<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Our Remote Learning Policy lays out in detail what our school will offer in the event of individual isolation, bubble close or full school closure due to Covid. • You can access all remote learning for your child via the school's website or your Class Dojo account. • Learning will be provided daily with a timetable for the week to enable children at home to follow the school routine as much as possible. • Recorded inputs by the teachers will be provided via a Zoom link for English and Maths and shared on Class Dojo daily. • From time to time, other video teaching inputs may be used from sites such as White Rose Maths, Oaks National Academy and YouTube. • A daily class Zoom will take place to allow all children, both in school and at home to feel connected. • Parents and Carers have been provided with a personalised login card which contains all the user names and passwords for their child for the online resources used by the school (TTRS, Spelling Shed, Class Dojo etc) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plan for the majority of lessons that would usually happen in the school day. • Ensure learning matches the curriculum needs of the pupils • Provide a suitable form of instruction, modelling or scaffolding for each lesson which is recorded and shared via Class Dojo. • Supplement lessons with activities, workbooks, textbooks, videos, good quality online resources and other suitable materials to ensure children are continuing their planned learning. • Upload learning to the school's website/Class Dojo page in a timely manner. • Assess learning either individually, as a group or whole class level and use this to inform what learning happens next. • Contact parents if required to discuss learning. • Where appropriate, a school mentor may be provided to support individuals with their remote learning. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stay safe online by completing the school's AUP with a parent/carer • Commit to completing all learning set by the class teacher daily. • Submit learning for feedback by the teacher via Class Dojo portfolio or by uploading/emailing a photo or file. • Listen or read carefully to instructions/ explanations given • Ask questions, if unsure how to complete learning. (via Class Dojo. • Join the daily class Zoom wherever possible. • Continue to read regularly and engage in other online resources such as Numbots/TTRS. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Familiarise themselves with the school's Remote Learning Policy • Know where to access the school's Remote Learning. • Ensure their child completes the expected learning set or communicate timely the reason it has not. • Know where and when to submit learning completed and support in this process if needed. • Have notified the school of their accessibility to a device so the best provision can be put into place. • Ensure their device is secure and they are following school protocols for using the online platform, agreeing to the school's AUPs. • Contact the school if their child is struggling to access the Remote Learning set so suitable support can be put in place.
