Y6 Activities

- **Bird song identifier**

Have someone play each bird song and use the bird song identifier sheet to point out which bird you think it is. Then they can tell you if you are correct or not.

If you don't have anyone to play the sound bites, why not listen anyway and look at the image of each bird provided for each sound bite.

- **Spot it!**

If you have a back garden and with your parent's permission go out and see if you can identify any of the birds on the bar chart sheet, record how many you see.

Or, just listen and try to identify the different bird songs.

Don't worry if you don't have a garden, maybe your adult will take you out – ask nicely!

Y6 Activities

- **Bird food recipes**

Choose a recipe and make bird food. When the bird food is ready hang them outside, stay very still and very quiet and watch what happens!

- **Encourage change**

Create a poster to show how to change our local environment for the better to encourage more garden birds.
