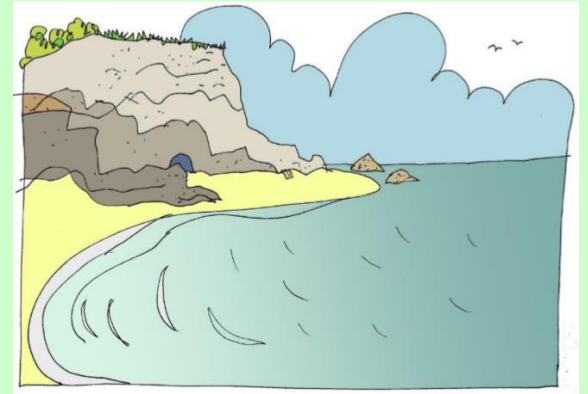

# Drawing your setting

Many authors say that they drew pictures of their setting, main characters and scenes from their stories.



To really help picture your main scene, have a go at sketching it out. This will help you to really picture and think of the details for your setting. It will give you something to look back on when writing your suspense story.

## Activity: Drawing your setting

Here are some things you might want to include in your drawing:

- Where is your treasure / object?
- Where are your main characters
- What are your main characters doing
- Where or what is your danger
- What is the weather/time of the day like?

You may also want to jot notes around your drawing to describe the weather etc.

**TIP!** This is a good opportunity to use a thesaurus to find amazing adjectives and powerful verbs.
