Now, choose from one of these book-related activities. You can do the activity based around any book/s you have read at home.

1. Draw a comic strip to retell a story.

2. Create a Top Trumps style game using your favourite characters from books you have read.

3. Choose an image from a picture book. Come up with 10 questions you could ask about the picture.

4. Create text messages between two characters in a book.

5. Write a letter to or from a character in a story.

6. Choose a section of text in a story. Rewrite it and change the adjectives and verbs to make it sound silly.

7. Write a list of the longest words you can find in one book (one for each letter of the alphabet).

8. Find as many fiction books as you can. Write out the first line from each story. Then put them in order from your most to least favourite lines.

9. Choose a story. Invent a new character and explain their role in the story.

10. Draw a map showing all the important locations in a particular story.
