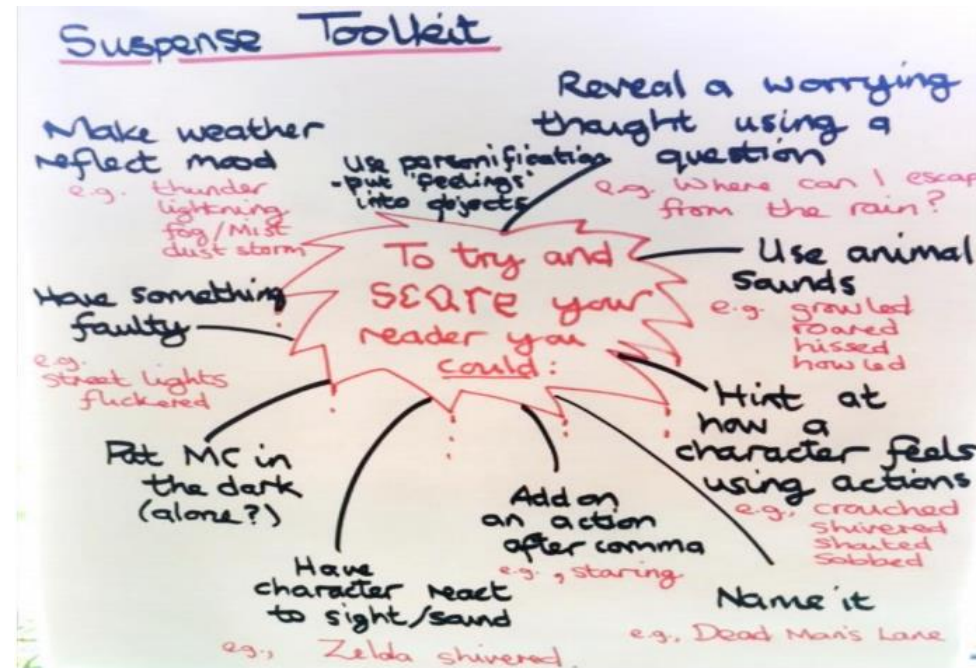


Activity - making a toolkit for suspense

To create suspense, we can use...

- **Show not tell:**
Rahul gripped Joe's arms.
- **Short snappy sentences**
They froze.
It moved.
Slam!
- **Speech moves the action on**
"Quick, in here!"
"Run!"
"Get out of here"!
- **Empty words/nouns**
somebody,
Someone,
It...
- **Threatening noises**
footsteps
water dripping
silence
creaky floorboards
- **Questions to make your reader think (rhetorical questions)**
Who was there?
What was it?
Would they make it?
