

Nursery Learning Activities w/b 22nd February 2021 The Rainbow Fish

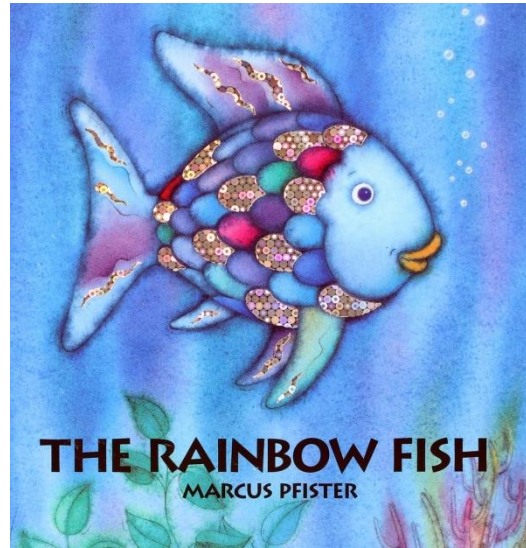

Understanding the World-

- A pdf of the Rainbow fish has been attached – can you decorate it?
- If you can find different things to put on your fish, can you talk about the different materials?
- E.g. tin foil is shiny
- What animals live in the sea? How are they different to other animals they know? How are they the same?
- Why is it important to look after the oceans?

Maths–

This week we are thinking about ordering:

- Write the numbers 1-10 on fish shapes/bits of paper that the children can order. As an extra challenge, the children could look at the numbers 10-20.
- In Nursery, we are going to order sea animals by size. What can the children find at home to order?

Phonics

Wake up Little Fish: (or another animal)

Explain that the fish has fallen asleep and can only be woken up by hearing the initial sound of an object that is picked out of a bag. If a bead is picked they need to whisper 'b' (getting louder until he wakes up!)
