

Nursery Learning Activities w/b 1st March 2021 Commotion in the Ocean

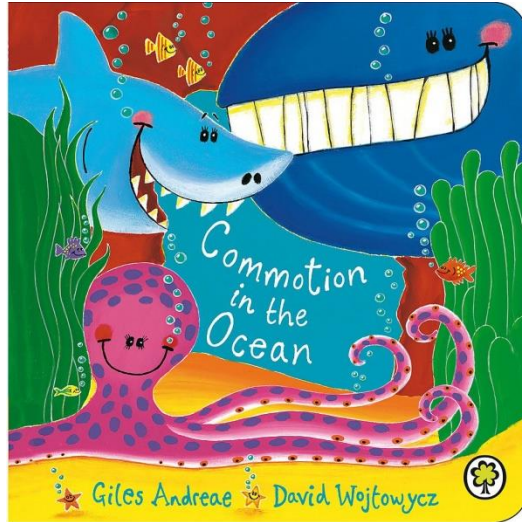
This week we are reading 'Commotion in the Ocean'. The children in Nursery loved learning about sea creatures and wanted to continue. The story is available through dojo class stories.

This week we will explore:

- Capacity (full/empty)
- Rhyming words
- Poetry
- Music (making a commotion!)

Please keep sharing to dojo all the amazing things you are doing at home as well.



Questions to ask this week?

- What is a poem? Do they have any at home? Do the grown-ups remember any poems to share?
- What animals was their favourite in the story?
- Can they tell you anything they know about that animal?
- What sea animal would they add to the book if they could? Why?
- What does 'commotion' mean? Can they make a commotion? (sorry grown-ups!)

Maths–

This week we are thinking about capacity:

- Which container will hold the most?
- How full is your container?
- How do you know?
- Can they guess how many cups it will take to fill a container?

Phonics

Making the 's' sound ('sssss' not 'ess')

Use the attached pdf to find the objects beginning with 'S'.

Phonics disco

Play a song, when the letter is shown make the sound (S). Dance until it is shown again! You will need S written on paper and music.

Mark Making

Writing the letter 's' – this could be in a tray with flour (or similar), start with writing with their finger then try with a stick/spoon etc
Can they find 'S' in the environment around them? On packets, signs etc
