Your activities today:

1. Research Andy Goldsworthy and his artwork. Some questions to think about.
 - What does he do?
 - How does he make his artwork?
 - What inspired him to do this?
 - How is his art different to other art you've seen?

2. Now study his artwork. Choose 4 pieces that stand out to you.
 - What do you like about them?
 - What do you dislike about them?
 - Do you think this is art?

If you were to make a similar piece of artwork, what would you do?

Sketch what you would try to make. You could even go outside and see if you can make your own!
