## Using clay

Clay is good for sculpting because it is very malleable before being heated. You can also paint and varnish it.

There are different types of clay such as porcelain clay, red clay and black clay.



## **Tools activity**

Investigate the effect of using different tools on clay.

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## Top clay tips

Use different tools to create different textures. Clay can be brittle and fragile if moulded too thinly.

When the clay becomes too sticky, add a little water.

If you add too much water, the clay will become too slippery to work with.

Once heated, coating the finished piece with varnish brings out the natural colour of the clay. Now sketch your design in your sketch book, remember Henry Moore's designs have lots of curves and you are using his sculptures as your inspiration.
