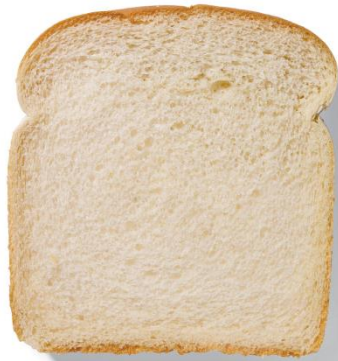

The four most common services that Christians might attend in Holy week; Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday.

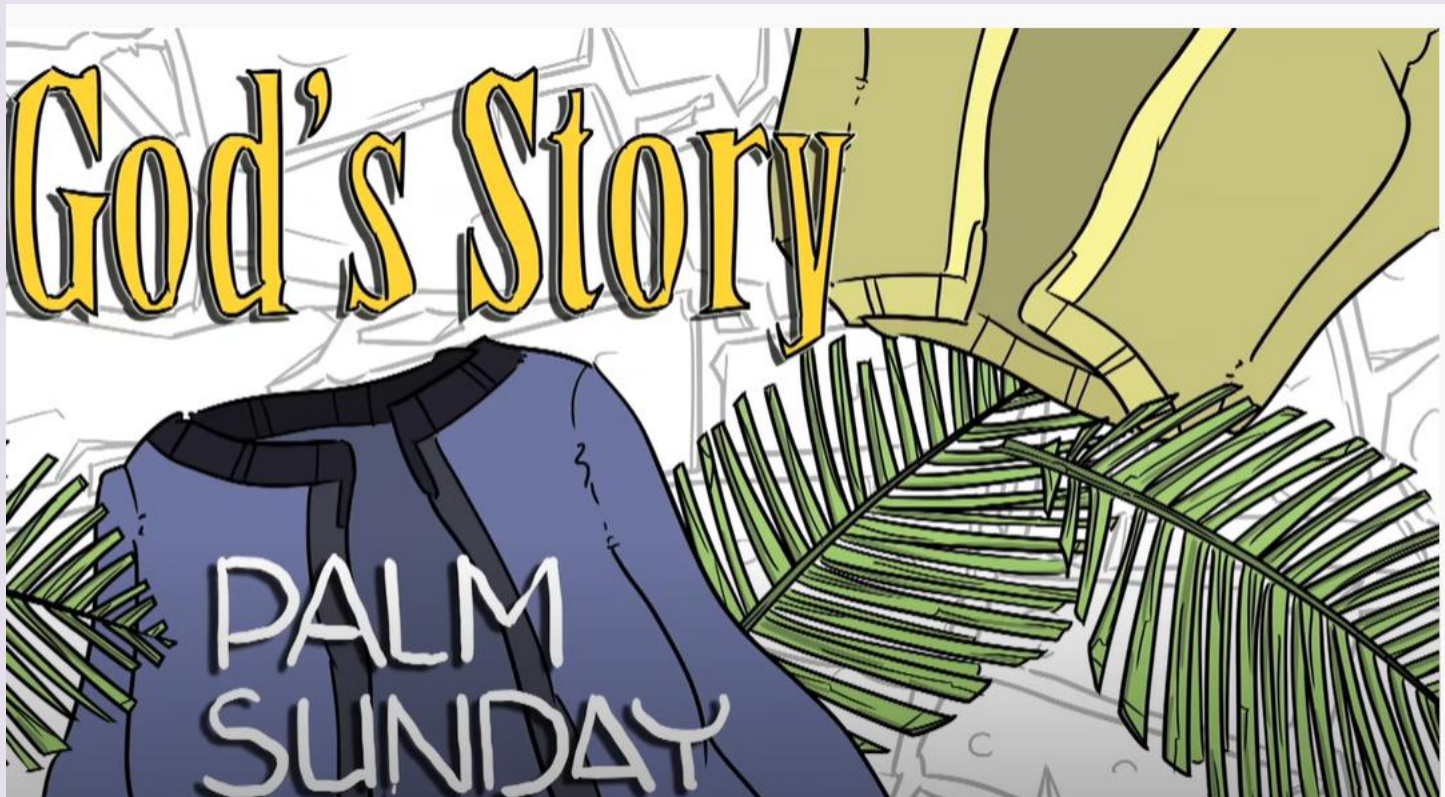
Can you suggest what Christians might do within these services?

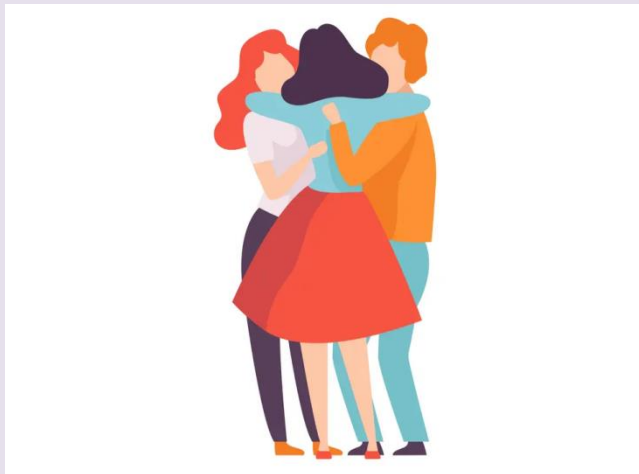


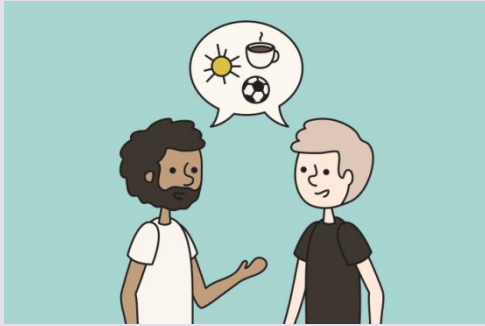
Why might these festivals be valuable, important to some people?
