Keep track of your day and see how time passes. What can you do in 30 seconds, a minute an hour? Discuss how long it would take to do different activities like clean your teeth or travel to London? Do you need seconds, minutes or hours? Challenge: Do you know your 5 times tables? Knowing them will help you tell the time to the nearest 5 minute intervals. E.g. Can you show 25 minutes past 3 on a clock?

Challenge 2- English

Keep a diary for a week. Be like Samuel Peyps. Write what you did and saw each day. Document the date and time of events.
