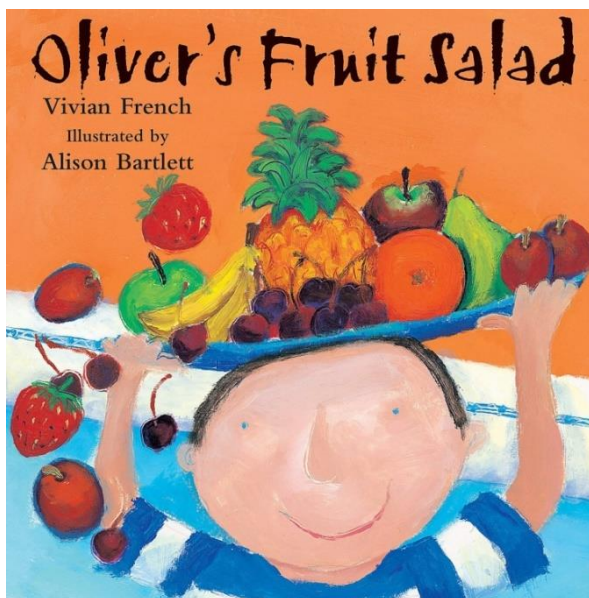


Year R Weekly Learning Activities – w/b 14th June 2021
