# What is a noun?

- A noun is a naming word.
- It is the name of a person, place or thing.

# What is a proper noun?

A **noun** that names a particular person, place, or thing "Tom," "Chicago," and "Friday" are **proper nouns**.

# What is a verb?

- A verb is a 'doing word.'
- It tells us what people (or things) are doing or being.
- Can be past, present or future

Sing, think, jump, walk, read

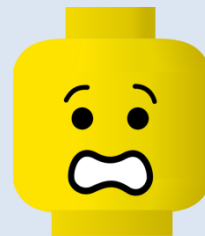
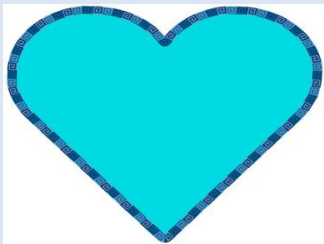


# What is an adjective?

- It tells you more about a noun
- Adjectives make your sentences more interesting.
