Make a model of a stone age house or person. No bigger than a shoe size box. You could either bring this to school or send a photo on Dojo.

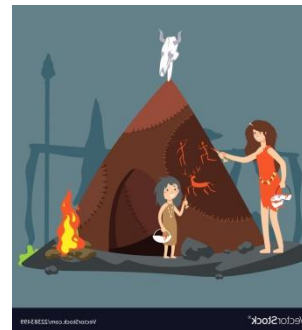


Challenge Two – English
