About our Breakfast Club and After School Club...

Breakfast Club is available every school day from 7:30am and After School Club runs until 6pm.

They both take place in our Small Hall in the Infant building. Charges are as follows:

Breakfast Club - £5 per day

After School Club - £12 per day

A limited number of funded places will be offered at Breakfast Club from 8:00am.

We are able to provide for up to 50 children from Reception to Year 6. All the children interact together, with the older pupils really looking after the younger pupils. It's like a lovely large family.

Breakfast Club

When the children arrive in the morning, we offer a wide range of both hot and cold breakfasts for them to choose from.



Each day there are a range of at least 6 cereals, yoghurts, tinned fruit, fresh fruit, squash, milk or water to drink. We also have toast, toasted muffins, crumpets, pancakes and sometimes bagels, all served with jam or marmite if desired.

On a weekly basis, there are baked beans, cheese, scrambled eggs or porridge available.

We will also cater for any dietary needs held on your child's school record.

Once a term we have a themed breakfast, the favourite being our French theme when we have croissants with jam, cheese or ham.

After breakfast, the children are able to choose from a variety of activities, such as board games, construction toys, games that promote gross motor control, sports equipment and an art/creative table is available for children to choose from too.

After School Club

At the end of the school day, children will be collected from their classroom and taken to the Small Hall by a member of Acorns Staff.

The session begins with some free time before the children come together for snack time. Children are offered a range of hot and cold snacks, including sandwiches, wraps, pitta bread, vegetable sticks and fruit.

There are a wide variety of activities on offer, based around a weekly theme.

When weather permits, the children can go outside to play in an enclosed area of the school outside space. This is the case for both morning and after school sessions.

At all times your children are supervised by fully qualified staff.

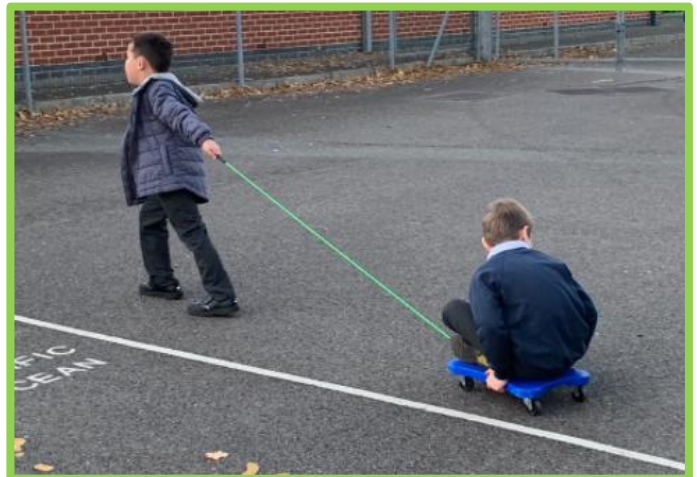
Every member of staff has Food Safety and Hygiene at Level 1 or 2.
